- **Peer-to-peer coaching** in the summer and winter semester 2022 (on- & offline). Expected dates: 18-20.3.2022 (getting to know each other); 7-8.5.2022 (defining a project); 9-11.9.2022 (conclusion)
- Participation in a 1-2 day conference of your choice on the topic of sustainability/the Sustainable Development Goals of the UN Agenda 2030 (costs will be covered up to a certain amount)
- The **implementation of a first project together** with the other students until November 2022 & **financial support** for the first project of approx. 700 Euros (depending on how many projects are created)
- Networking with other motivated and committed arts students (approx. 15 participants in total) and Arts of Change alumni
- An **expense allowance** of 100 euros for your commitment
- Integration and final presentation of the project within the framework of UniNEtZ Universities for Sustainable Development Goals
- Important: **There are no costs for you**. If the Covid-measures allow physical meetings in the summer and winter semester 2022, travel costs, accommodation costs and costs of food will be covered!
